### RULES OF CONDUCT

- Coaches must display good conduct at all times in front of the boys. They must never argue between themselves or with other officials in front of any boy or parent.
- No coach shall ever, unless teaching a fundamental stance or play; grab, punch, or hit any player under his supervision.
- No coach shall use any derogatory remarks toward any boy under his supervision.
- The use of profanity is strictly forbidden all times.
- No coach shall badger, ridicule, or harass any official; nor shall he allow a team member to do so during a game.
- No coach shall accost any official assigned to his game during or following such game or use derogatory or abusive language. He may, at any time during or after play, request information related to some infraction. (Texas S.F.O.A policies apply)
- No coach shall purposely teach any boy under his care any unethical practice.
- No coach may reward or offer incentives to players in any way for an act injurious to another player.
- No coach may punish a player in any way for inadvertently incurring a penalty.
- Every coach must instill the spirit to win, but above all, teach good sportsmanship whether they win or lose.

### DEPORTMENT

- A coach who is guilty of improper field decorum to the extent that his team is penalized for his actions or is ejected from the game by a game official must be reported to the Conference Athletic Director or President by his Booster Club within 48 hours for appropriate action.
- Game officials have the right to eject a player from the game for persistent unsportsmanlike conduct. Such ejection must be similarly reported.
- Booster Club officials are responsible for the deportment of their own supporters. Alcoholic beverages and profane or abusive language in the stands or parking lot must not be tolerated.
- There shall be no smoking on the playing field or in the bench area.
- The Booster Club President is responsible for all actions of Booster Club personnel, participants, and their spectators -- both on and off this field.

The season playing and practice schedule were adopted by the Booster Clubs. Team practice scheduling is a Club function within the limitations defined in the rule book: 1 1/2 hours maximum (no minimum) per team practice session, per day; daily until first game; Then three (3) per week but never Sunday.

An official team practice starts (and continues for that period of time) when three (3) or more team members and one (1) or more coaches assemble anywhere for practice, instruction, scrimmage, and / or lectures (including other TIFI games and game film / tape review). Any team activity (scrimmage, etc.) with any other team request prior approval by the Conference President. Practice rules and penalties are defined in section 9.00 of the TIFI Rule Book.

All excessive winning margins of more than 40 points that could embarrass a team will be reviewed by the Conference Board per TIFI Rule 15.06. All coaches are subject to background checks.
